

URBAN FOOD GARDEN SEEDLING PROPAGATION WORKSHOP



Practical workshop covering a range of seedling propagation subjects including :-

- Practical session where you set up your own Styrofoam seedling propagating box.
- How to make your own seedling mix.
- Protecting your seedlings from pests.
- Seedling fertilisers.
- Planting seedlings out.
- The pros and cons of various propagating boxes and pots.
- How to make your own heated propagating box.
- The merits of commercial seedling mixes.
- Which vegetables are suitable to be grown as seedlings.

Soil, seedling mix and manures will be provided. There will also be seeds to plant but people are encouraged to bring along their own seeds, both to plant and to swap with others. Ideal seeds to plant in a propagating box at this time of year include: Lettuce, tomato, basil, capsicum, celery, eggplant, chilli, leek and Silverbeet.
