As these guides did not differentiate between planting seeds or seedlings or show when to plant in seedling boxes they have been adapted to the BALLARAT & DISTRICT LEGEND (above). As every garden has its own microclimate all guides should be seen as only a rough guide. Gardeners are encouraged to experiment with these guides to see what best suites their own garden.
